As systems become more complex, students from underserved communities face increased barriers to opportunity, while support systems often lag behind.

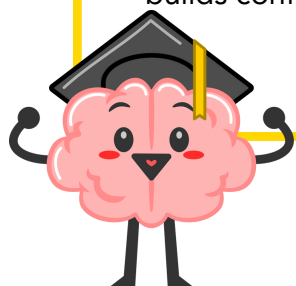


## WHY EQUITY MATTERS

- Over 80% of Black students graduate with student loan debt, and many lack access to early financial literacy education or scholarship navigation support.
- Students from low-income backgrounds are often underexposed to alternative pathways like trades, entrepreneurship, or early career opportunities—resulting in wage gaps, missed or delayed success.
- Underserved students often carry higher stress loads due to systemic inequities, and may not receive structured support in developing critical SEL skills like resilience, confidence, and time management.
