PREP Pathways is a structured, future-ready framework designed to help students build life readiness, clarify postsecondary pathways, and create actionable plans—without adding burden to school staff.


The PREP Pilot offers schools a low-risk, high-impact way to explore implementation within existing advisory or college and career readiness structures.

WHAT IS THE PREP PILOT?

The PREP Pilot is a 6-8 week College & Career Readiness experience designed for short instructional periods (20–35 minutes).

It integrates purpose development, readiness skills, pathway exploration, and planning—so students don't just choose a path, they're prepared to manage it.

PREP focuses on readiness in context, connecting life skills directly to postsecondary success rather than treating them as stand-alone lessons.



These competencies are embedded directly into postsecondary planning work—supporting real-world application and follow-through.

PREP PILOT AT A GLANCE

- Duration: 6-8 weeks
- Sessions: 2 per week
- Time per session: 20–35 minutes (adaptable)
- Setting: Advisory, CCR blocks, or similar times
- Facilitation: External facilitator during pilot phase
- Audience: Middle & high school students
- Ideal pilot grades: 10–12 (adaptable)

Durations are flexible to the school's needs and bell schedule*



WHY SCHOOLS CHOOSE PREP

Most college and career readiness programs focus on exposing students to options.

PREP Pathways focuses on **readiness**.

Through the pilot, students build:

- Time management and self-management skills
- Communication and self-advocacy
- Financial awareness and career realism
- Decision-making and planning skills



WHAT STUDENTS LEAVE WITH

By the end of the pilot, students complete:

- A **Purpose Profile** (identity, values, direction)
- A **Life Readiness Snapshot** (skills and habits)
- A **Career Reality Snapshot** (pathway alignment)
- Increased clarity around postsecondary options
- A personalized **6–12 month action plan**



HOW THE PILOT IS IMPLEMENTED

- Designed to fit within existing schedules
- Minimal lift for counselors and educators
- Delivered by an external facilitator during the pilot phase
- Feedback and reflection built into the experience



Schools receive insights that can inform future programming and next-step planning.
